



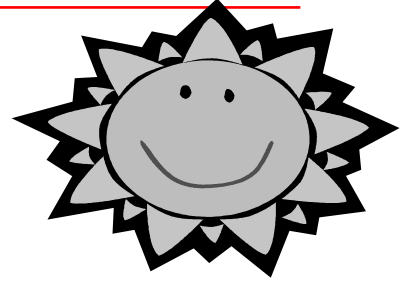

New Tour and Enrollment Referral Program!

Whenever you, as a currently enrolled parent, **refer another parent to tour** any one of our centers, you will **receive a tuition credit of \$25.00** for each family you refer for a tour. Returning families must have been absent for at least one year before they can be used for a tour credit by another family. Families may only be referred for a tour one time per year.

Whenever you, as a currently enrolled parent, **refer another parent that enrolls** at any one of our centers, you will **receive a tuition credit equal to one week of your current tuition** after the new family has been enrolled in our center for four complete weeks. Also, the newly enrolled parent's registration fee will be credited after four complete weeks of enrollment. Returning families must have been absent for at least one year before they can be referred by another family. You may only refer a family one time to receive the tuition credit. Please see your center Director for more details.

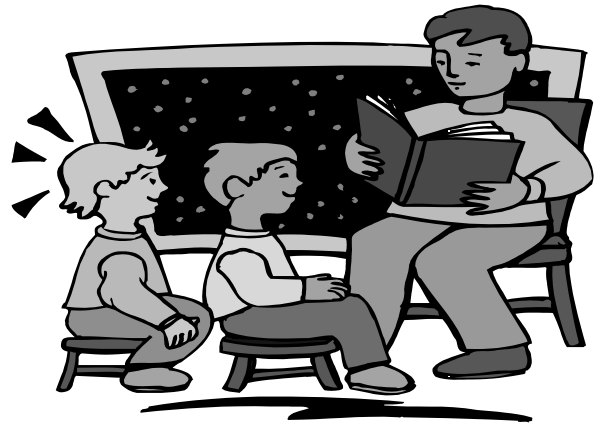
Upcoming Events
